Side hinged, personnel and smart pass doors employ high grade corrosion protected hinges for smooth operation and elimination of leaf "sag".



All doors feature a strong sub-chassis with bracing plates to ensure rigidity of the door panel.





Standard doors have top and bottom cable operated lock latches to the active leaf and shoot bolts to the inactive leaf for dependable security.

Steel bracing gives side hinged doors a robust feel in every day use. The standard configuration shown above uses twin latches on the active leaf and shoot boths on the inactive leaf. Hold-open stays are available as an option.





Insulated Side Hinged garage doors

STEEL

Fort's range of insulated side hinged garage doors is proudly designed and built at our production facility in Birmingham.

Every detail has been carefully considered and designed to make a stand-out door. We form complete door panels at our factory for perfect looks, proportions and performance, inside and out.

Dual steel skins bonded to a thermal core create 20mm thick insulated panels. Panels are mounted in specially extruded aluminium surrounds and completed with an aluminium frame. All components are precision machined for the ideal combination of high-grade engineering, great performance and stunning good looks.





Matching side doors are also available.

Door Stays are included as standard on double leaf doors

2.8 W/m²K

At 2.8 (based on a 2250mm x U-Value 2040mm door), the Fort insulated door compares favourably to some types of double-glazed windows.





As standard, every door has a robust handle, latch and deadlock with an adjustable keep for precise latching and an internal thumb turn for effortless operation.



Double seals to the door leaf and frame help protect against the weather and limit dust and debris entering your garage.



A gasket between the door leaf frame and insulated panel further helps seal the door against the elements.



The colour matched hinges are adjustable in 3 directions, allowing for easy alignment of the leaves, should it be required.



Concealed shoot bolts at the top and bottom of the inactive leaf hold the door securely in place. The adjustable keeps allow for easy alignment of the leaf position for a precise fit.



Options



For an added level of security, 3-point locking with twin hook locks, is available as an option. (Minimum over-frame height 1600mm)



Stainless steel pull handles are a sleek alternative to the standard lever handle and are supplied with a ball catch and deadlock.



Doors are also available with solid and/or glazed over and side panels - ask for details.

All doors also available 1/3:2/3 split, excluding doors with traditional windows, which are only available with a 50:50 split.

All doors are supplied fully finished, won't warp, shrink or rust and are virtually maintenance free. Doors are available in white gloss and woodgrain styles.





Sectional garage doors are made from strong, 40mm thick, insulated panels. The insulation reduces heat and sound transmission and the bottom compression seal, side and top seals help keep out draughts, making your garage a more pleasant space.

Product Guarantees

In the unlikely event of a warranty claim, please contact your dealer that installed your garage door and supply them details of the serial number on the side or back of the garage door.

Your dealer will supply further details of the claim along with proof of purchase to the warranty department at Fort Doors.

Warranty period

A warranty covering the safe and reliable operation of the Fort Doors garage door for a period of 10 years from the date of purchase is given to the original purchaser, this warranty is for help and advice on the safety and reliability of the product and identifying parts and consumables in the event of a failure.

Product Guarantee

The standard guarantee of 2 years is given to the holder of the product that covers all parts and the panel providing the serial number is readable, intact and in place. Factory applied paint finishes have 2 years on steel doors that have standard colours applied, special non-standard colours are excluded.

The product is given a 2-year warranty for the following item – springs; tracks; rollers; hinges and locking for normal use whereby normal use consists of no more than 5 operations (open/close) per day. We recommend the product is inspected and serviced annually by a competent engineer from the garage door industry, the warranty for parts replaced by an engineer or for supply only is 6 months or for the remainder of the warranty period. All cables are excluded from the warranty given.

If warranty work is carried out the product guarantee does not extend past the anniversary of installation / supply date.

Requirements

Warranties are valid in the UK only for European countries contact you dealer.

The product must have been purchased through one of our authorised partners and a serial number and receipt of purchase provided.

The warranty only covers damage to the garage door in the unlikely event of a failure, no surrounding items are covered.

Performance

During the warranty period we will rectify defects to the Fort product that can be proved to be material or manufacturing faults. At our discretion we will either exchange; repair or reduce the price. we will not accept any costs for dismantling; installation or delivery.

Warranty exclusions.

Doors must be inspected on delivery and are only to be signed for once you are satisfied with the condition, please do not accept any item you are not satisfied with. You have 3 days from receipt of the item to inform us of any issues. By installing the garage door, the customer acknowledges and accepts the condition of the door as it stands post-delivery, no claim for damage will be accepted once the item has been installed.

Improper transport; fitting and adjustment.

Repairs by non-qualified or non-competent individuals.

External influences such as fire, water, alkaline solutions, acid, bird droppings or abnormal atmospheric pollution.

The use of non-Fort Doors parts without the approval of the manufacturer.

Damage caused in general use after delivery.

All cables have a limited warranty of 2 years for parts only, cables should be checked regularly and adjusted by a recognised installer, a list of service engineers is available from the Fort customer service department. Failure to inspect, adjust or replace damaged cables early can cause a terminal failure of the product and prevent entry into the garage.

Painted doors give an outstanding finish compared to hand painted doors however they can be scratched or chipped by everyday use, refer to the internal label for care and maintenance of your door, The paint finish is cosmetic and the front panel should be uniform when viewed from 3 meters distance, we offer a 2 year warranty against paint failure, minor blemishes in the finish are inevitable .The rear of the door will not enjoy such a uniform finish by its nature and will have a different level of coating due to the manufacturing process however this does not affect the performance of the product and all doors are supplied galvanized and Painted or galvanized only giving outstanding external use.

Doors fitted within 250m of the coast line (where the beach ends and the land begins) and inland estuary are exempt from the paint finish warranty and we recommend a GRP Composite material.

Additional information.

It is a fundamental condition of this guarantee that the product has been installed, maintained, cleaned and serviced correctly and is used solely for which it was designed.

Incorrect installation, maintenance and service will invalidate the warranty.

The door must be kept in a clean condition and free from impact damage, any areas of paint damage must be dressed with touch up paint as soon as possible.
